

Prof. Gerold Stucki, MD, MS

Gerold Stucki is Professor and Chair of the Department of Health Sciences and Medicine at the University of Lucerne and Director of Swiss Paraplegic Research (SPF) in Switzerland. After his medical studies and his clinical training in Physical and Rehabilitation Medicine (PRM) and Rheumatology, he obtained a Master of Science in Health Policy and Management from the Harvard School of Public Health (USA) and a diploma in Biostatistics and Epidemiology from the University of McGill (Canada). In 2003, Gerold Stucki initiated the ICF Research Branch (www.icf-research-branch.org), an international research network with various cooperation partners worldwide. In 2018, Gerold Stucki established the “Center for Rehabilitation in Global Health Systems”, a WHO Collaborating Center at the University of Lucerne.
